- Admission Fee (compulsory one-off payment only for new pupils) €350
- Registration Fee (compulsory for continuing pupils) €250 p.a.
- Parents/Guardians Association subscription (compulsory) \*<sup>1</sup> €40 p.a.
- All Day School (option available only for Years 1-3) \*<sup>2</sup> €600 p.a. (2 instalments: Oct. & Jan.)
- Lunch (option available for all Years) €650 p.a. (5 instalments: Oct.-Feb.)
- Breakfast (option available only for athletes of all Years) €350 p.a. (5 instalments: Oct.-Feb.)
- Lab Fees/Consumables (compulsory for Years 4-6):
  - Chemistry IGCSE/A Level €60 p.a. (1 instalment: Oct.)
  - Biology IGCSE/A Level €60 p.a. (1 instalment: Oct.)

    - For pupils who joined the Athletic Section in September 2020 €300 p.a. (1 instalment: Sep.)
    - For pupils joining the Athletic Section in September 2021 €500 p.a. (1 instalment: Sep.)
  - Larnaka:
    - For pupils who joined the Athletic Section in September 2020 €500 p.a. (1 instalment: Sep.)
    - For pupils joining the Athletic Section in September 2021 €500 p.a. (1 instalment: Sep.)
  - Lemesos:
    - For pupils joining the Athletic Section in September 2021 €500 p.a. (1 instalment: Sep.)
- Excursions (compulsory for Lefkosia) €16 p.a. (1 instalment: Sep.)
- External Exams Support Lessons (optional for Years 4-6 only in Lefkosia) €200 p.a. (1 instalment: Sep.) per subject
- Additional optional subject (optional for Years 4-6 only in Lefkosia & Lemesos) €200 p.a. (1 instalment: Sep.)

### NOTES:

1. Our Year 1 corresponds to Year 7 of the UK educational system.
2. On Registration the following are payable (total €2,000 for new pupils / €1,900 for continuing pupils):
  - Admission Fee or Registration Fee €350 or €250
  - Parents/Guardians Association subscription €40
  - Towards annual Tuition Fees €1,610
3. The balance of the annual Tuition Fees is payable in 6 equal instalments (September-February)
4. \*<sup>1</sup> Parents/Guardians Association subscription:
  - €40 per family for 1 child
  - €10 additionally per family per sibling
  - In Larnaka the pupils of the Athletic Section pay an additional €10 for the Personal Accident Insurance Policy. In Lefkosia and Lemesos the insurance policy is included in the Parents/Guardians Association subscription.

- Parents/Guardians Association subscription for PASCAL Primary Schools is paid separately.
5. Sibling discount of €500 is given on the Tuition Fees of each of the older children.
  6. If the Tuition Fees are paid in full then the following discounts apply:
    - 7% discount if the Tuition Fees are paid in full until 23 December 2020
    - 5% discount if the Tuition Fees are paid in full until 31 March 2021
    - 3% discount if the Tuition Fees are paid in full until 9 July 2021
  7. \*2 All Day School:
    - In Lefkosia the subjects taught are Mathematics, Science and English. Mathematics is taught two times a week whereas Science and English are each taught once a week. Pupils may choose to follow only one subject once a week, i.e. Science or English and the fee is €150 p.a. per subject.
    - In Larnaka the subjects taught are Mathematics, Science and English. English is taught two times a week whereas Science and Mathematics are each taught once a week. Pupils may choose to follow only one subject once a week, i.e. Science or Mathematics and the fee is €150 p.a. per subject.
    - In Lemesos the subjects taught are Mathematics, Science and English and pupils must follow all three. Hence the fee for this package is €600 p.a.
  8. The cost for the school uniform, the books (excluding the ones provided for free by the Cyprus Ministry of Education, Culture, Sport and Youth), the school transportation, the extra-curricular activities and the participation in competitions, conferences, etc. is not included in this pricelist. More information regarding these costs can be obtained from the school reception.
  9. The fee for the external examinations depends on the subject/level/examination body and is charged separately.
  10. Fees can be settled via several school fees payment bank schemes, thus saving a significant amount of money, with up to 14 monthly instalments. Fees can also be settled via credit card, JCC Smart, monthly instalments by credit card or standing order.
  11. Tuition and other fees are reviewed annually. Any possible increment on the tuition fees has a cap of 5% on the fees of each Year group for an academic year.
  12. Admission Fee, Registration Fee, Tuition Fees, Parents/Guardians Association subscription and Athletic Section Fee are not refundable under any circumstances as they guarantee (represent a deposit) a pupil's attendance at school for at least one school year. Hence, this is not simply an advance fee payment.
  13. The inability to continue with school lessons, for whatever reason, does not exempt the parent/guardian/pupil from the obligation to pay the school fees for the whole academic year. Any balance of fees due upon the departure of a pupil from the school, irrespective of the date of departure, must be paid in full. In the event that fees of a pupil were paid in full and the pupil ceases to attend the school, no refund is applicable. The departure of any pupil in no way minimizes the school's running costs.
  14. A Late Payment Penalty Fee of €50 per month applies if the payment is not made by the applicable instalment deadline.
  15. The school has the right to withdraw scholarships, monetary prizes or discounts in case the fees are not paid by the applicable instalment deadline.
  16. The Teachers Council has the right to withdraw scholarships, monetary prizes or discounts in case of serious disciplinary incident or disciplinary infringement.
  17. For those pupils whose fees are met partially or in total by the Cyprus Government (such as Maronites, Armenians, Latins, repatriated Cypriots, Turkish-Cypriots and so on), it is the obligation of the parents/guardians/pupils to settle the school fees according to the applicable deadlines irrespective of when they are credited by the Government.
  18. Enrolment in the subsequent school year will be accepted only once the due fees and other financial obligations have been settled.
